

The Hafesa Group expands its network of service stations in the province of Granada by opening a new one in Churriana de la Vega

- Promoted by Hafesa Oil, a division of the Hafesa Group, the new station is supplied directly from DBA Motril Port, one of the Group's main terminals in Spain.
- The company already has four service stations in different parts of the country: La Zubia (Granada), Valdepeñas (Ciudad Real), Sardón de Duero (Valladolid) and As Marismas (Pontevedra).
- Hafesa Oil is moving ahead with its growth strategy by opening of new service stations near the Group's storage plants.

Granada, 20 April 2023. Hafesa Oil, a division of the <u>Hafesa Group</u>, the holding company involved in marketing and distributing petroleum products, has opened a new service station in the province of Granada, at Churriana de la Vega. The station is at number 11, C/ San Ramón, just 200 metres from the Alhambra main road, and represents a new supply point in the Hafesa Oil network in Granada after the opening last year of the service station at La Zubia.

At the Churriana de la Vega station, drivers can refuel with Diesel A and 95 petrol with IT Tech technology – a product recommended for prolonging the useful life of engines and improving their performance. This facility, as well as the one in La Zubia, are supplied directly from one of the main plants the Hafesa Group owns in Spain: DBA Motril Port.

Opening hours are from 7am to 11pm, seven days a week. The station has four pumps, as well as selling butane gas and firewood. The main advantages of this service station include personalised attention – as the attendants serve users on the forecourt they can refuel and pay without getting out of their car. The facilities also include a modern convenience store, Hafeshop, with a wide selection of products.

The opening of this new service station and others that will begin operations this year are included in Hafesa Oil's strategic expansion and growth plan, based on the opening of new service stations around Hafesa Group storage plants.

For Javier Ramos, managing director of Hafesa Oil, "The Churriana de la Vega station is one more example of our commitment to continue growing in this sector in excellent strategic locations that allow us to continue offering our service model, with attended forecourt service personalised for all customers, and the best fuels, always at the most competitive prices."
